## **The National Academies**


- The National Academies is the umbrella "brand" for the National Research Council (NRC), National Academy of Sciences, National Academy of Engineering, and the Institute of Medicine
  - NAS is the part originally chartered by Abraham Lincoln in 1863
- One function of NRC is to "survey" fields of science and engineering
  - Snapshot of recent progress
  - Assessment of emerging research directions
  - Recommendations (to govm't, scientific community, and society) for strategies to realize most ripe and compelling opportunities
- NRC's Board on Physics and Astronomy conducts a survey of physics, subfield by subfield, every ~10 years (takes about 10 years!)
- *Physics in a New Era* wrapped up in 2001. The new exercise is called *Physics 2010.*
- This new cycle reflects some key changes in the approach
  - Less inward-looking; involve "neighbors" and "outsiders"
  - Avoid an exhaustive catalog; identify clear priorities

#### Elementary Particle Physics 2010

- Report released in late April 2006
- Radical approach resulted in unusually strong report



#### Atomic, Molecular, Optical Physics 2010

- Report released in July 2006
- Framed the science in compelling, simple questions



### **Condensed-Matter and Materials Physics 2010**

- Report released in June 2007
- Framed the future of the science, made strong linkages to other fields

#### Plasma Science 2010

- Report released in May 2007
- Highlights broad impact and intellectual unity...
