Enhancing Research Transparency

- The DOE Office of Science (SC) is enhancing transparency in the basic research it sponsors in the physical sciences by making more information about our research awards publicly accessible
- Improved research transparency will promote scientific **collaboration** while building **trust** and fostering **accountability** with the American people
- On July 12, 2025, the SC Portfolio Analysis and Management System (PAMS) began publicly sharing more information about our research program, including:
 - Public abstracts for both SC grants and laboratory awards
 - Annual public research performance progress reports for SC grants
- On October 4, 2025, the **SC Portfolio Analysis and Management System (PAMS) launched integration with Energy Link (E-Link)**, DOE's submission system for scientific and technical information (STI), managed by the Office of Scientific and Technical Information (OSTI)
 - Provides an efficient “one-stop shop” for submitting research products for annual progress reporting to the agency and dissemination of research results to the public
- Future updates will implement public progress reports for SC Laboratory Awards



Streamlining Required Public Reporting

- SC Financial Assistance Award recipients are required to provide scientific and technical products and a public Final Technical Report to OSTI through [E-Link](#)
 - The [OSTI.gov](#) portal makes this information publicly available
- Awardees are also required to report research products as part of their annual Research Performance Progress Report (RPPR), which generates a Public Progress Report



- The PAMS/E-Link system integration streamlines and enhances the process of reporting scientific and technical products
 - Awardees will not need to report the same product in two different systems
 - E-Link capabilities to insert metadata based on persistent identifiers makes product reporting easier
 - PAMS and E-Link share information to further streamline reporting and enhance findability of data

Journal Articles

 - The required metadata fields will automatically change based on the reported publication status
- Certain fields in all records are prepopulated based on the PAMS data for your award
 - Award number, Originating research organization, Sponsoring organization, Point of contact information
 - All prepopulated fields are editable

Navigating While Creating or Editing a Product

- The “Required Fields” section on the left of each product screen helps you quickly navigate through the product record
 - Each section is a clickable button allowing you to jump to that section
 - Specific required elements of a section show a green check mark  if complete or a red X  if incomplete
- Validations help ensure accurate and complete data entry
 - Certain fields are checked for validity during data entry


