





### **Site Access – By the Numbers**

## **Progress to Date – Most Impactful Improvements**



- Substantially improved communications
  - Hundreds of questions, dozens of stakeholder meetings, frank and open conversations
- Opening of major buildings to badged personnel
- Single-Form Access Request
  - Access request process streamlined and release of invitation system
  - Approval times have reduced by a factor ~3 due to fewer steps and reduction of errors
- Re-opening of public spaces in Wilson Hall
  - Completion of access control system in non-public spaces



# **Security & Safety Areas: Current**

#### Public GAA

- Open to public, REAL ID for site access
- Wilson Hall
  - Ground floor (excl. S&R, machine shop, etc.)
  - Atrium & Cafeteria
  - Auditoriums
  - WH-2X Art Gallery/Conference Rooms
- Building 327
- · Lederman Science Center
- · Nature areas & bison viewing
- · Aspen East Fermilab Welcome Center

#### Business

- Buildings open to appropriate badged personnel and business visitors
- · Includes leased farmlands
- Non-public business roads indicated in blue

### Safety

- Badged personnel with required training and hazard mitigations
- Non-public safety roads indicated in brown



#### Security (PPA)

Higher security, access limited to individuals appropriately screened and approved by line management. Security Areas designated as PPA based upon Security Risk Analysis and DOE O 473.1A and 470.3C

- Specific Buildings or labs
- · Controls implemented at the Building
