

Geoffrey Greene is Professor of Physics at the University of Tennessee and holds a joint appointment with Oak Ridge National Laboratory. He received his PhD from Harvard University in 1977, and BA from Swarthmore College in 1971. He has served on numerous advisory panels in the US and Europe and is currently the Scientific Director of the Fundamental Neutron Physics Beamline at the Spallation Neutron Source at Oak Ridge National Laboratory. He has served in management positions at Los Alamos National Laboratory and on the staff at the National Institute of Standards and Technology. His research is focused on the the measurement of fundamental constants and tests of fundamental symmetries.
