I am pleased to inform you of the Office of Science's acceptance of the Earned Value Management System (EVMS) at Fermi National Accelerator Laboratory (FNAL). In July 2025, an independent surveillance/EVMS review was conducted based on the existing EVMS application on the High Luminosity Large Hadron Collider Compact Muon Solenoid Detector Upgrade and the Proton Improvement Plan II projects. In September 2025, the FNAL Management & Operating (M&O) contractor submitted a Corrective Action Plan (CAP) to address the Corrective Action Requests and Continuous Improvement Opportunities identified by the EVMS review committee. While the actions proposed and undertaken by the FNAL M&O in the CAP were deemed acceptable and meet the requirements of the Electrical Industries Alliance -748, I would like to request an increased focus on addressing the unresolved issues noted during the previous review in 2023.
