Description of Proposed Action

UChicago Argonne, LLC, proposes to lease office space at the University of Chicago campus in Chicago, Illinois, to provide a location for the downtown Chicago presence of Argonne National Laboratory. The space would provide office, conference and common facilities (restrooms and break/coffee stations) totaling approximately 20,000 square feet. The leased space would be shared to promote education and workforce development initiatives, research collaboration, and other interactions among the building licensees, including representatives of universities, other research institutions and commercial enterprises. Tenants would reserve the use of individual offices, cubicles, and conference rooms as needed by utilizing a reservation system. The use of the space would be limited to office type activities including data analysis or report preparation. The building was constructed by and fitted out with furniture and equipment by the University.

Description of Affected Environment

The University of Chicago operates a shared research space whereby members who acquire a license receive the right to access and use portions of the space. The University of Chicago is the landlord of the subject building and leases the space to various entities. Proposed lease would be of real property office space, located on floors 4 through 12, within the real property and improvements commonly known as 5235 S. Harper Court in Chicago, Illinois.
